- Revenue through March 31 was \$6.422M expenditures were \$6.078M
- A little off compared with budget; above projected budget by \$89,000

- On track to open May 4- July 10 10 weeks, 10 hours a week for a total of 100 instruction hours.
- We gave informational presentations 4 times a day; 70 sessions total via zoom
- currently 2 9 am 51 students
