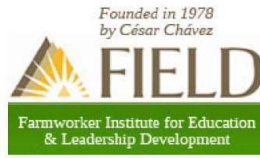

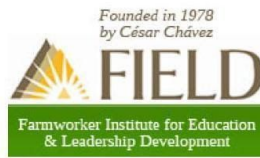

It is recommended that the EPIC Board of Directors approve the hiring of said teachers who qualify and have applied for or are in the process of applying to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing for a Provisional Internship Permit on the basis of a BA/BS degree earned, and applicable university courses taken.

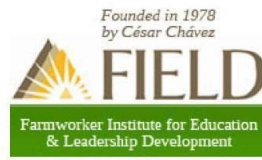
